B	<a href="#">Belsaw</a>	Sharpening systems, housewares
P	<a href="#">Buffalo tools</a>	Misc shop, some gensets
B	<a href="#">Craftsman</a>	Great hand and power tool brand
H	<a href="#">Cummins</a>	Diesel truck tools
P	<a href="#">Cummings Tools</a>	Machine and power tools, older
P	<a href="#">Delta (later as Rockwell)</a>	Sold home shop saws, jointers
B/P	<a href="#">Dewalt</a>	Journeyman level hand and power
P	<a href="#">Dormeyer</a>	Old drills (and some kit mixers!)
P	<a href="#">Dremel</a>	Rotary tools and accs. Saws, too
B	<a href="#">Dunlap</a>	Sears gearhead and wood tools
P	<a href="#">Durex (Canadian roots)</a>	General hand tools, some soldering
B	<a href="#">Dyno Mite (Miller-Falls brand)</a>	Odd power unit and accessories
B/P	<a href="#">Foley (with Belsaw)</a>	Locksmith and saw sharpening
H	<a href="#">GMC</a>	Specialized auto repair tools
B	<a href="#">Harbor Freight</a>	Everything - power and hand
H	<a href="#">Herders</a>	Gunsmithing and reloading tools
P	<a href="#">Jet</a>	Saws, lathes, planers, more
P	<a href="#">King (Seeley)</a>	Some hand, a few power (see Sears)
B	<a href="#">K-Mart</a>	Drills, sanders, soldering, polishers
P	<a href="#">Manning-Bowman Tools</a>	Drills, Saws, danders - also coffee pots
B/P	<a href="#">Milwaukee</a>	Journeyman level hand and power
B/P	<a href="#">Montgomery Wards (PowrKraft)</a>	Power and hand, good vintage
P	<a href="#">Porter Cable</a>	Mainly power good long-term tools
P	<a href="#">Power Kraft spelled variously</a>	More M. Wards hand tools, power
B	<a href="#">PowerMite (Ideal) Tools</a>	Mainly kid's drills and hand tools (Ideal)
B	<a href="#">Precision-Bilt (Speigel)</a>	Quirky handtools, drills
H	<a href="#">Pro Craft (Hilka)</a>	Odd power, mostly hand and measuring
B	<a href="#">RadioShack</a>	Electronic tools, soldering gear, flashlights
B	<a href="#">Remington (occasionally Mall)</a>	Powder driven tools, some gas, some electric
P	<a href="#">Ryobi</a>	Asia maker of everything
P	<a href="#">Seeley (King) for Sears Craftsman</a>	Made a lot for Sears in Craftsman heyday
P	<a href="#">Shopmate</a>	Vintage sanders, drills, saws, etc
P	<a href="#">Shop Smith (Mark series and more)</a>	Interesting all-in-one machines
P	<a href="#">Speedway (Thor)</a>	Cross section of sanders, drills, etc
P	<a href="#">Sprunger</a>	Industrial grade drill presses, hacksaws
B	<a href="#">Stanley</a>	Drills, plam trimmers, sanders
P	<a href="#">Talg-Axminster (see also Sherline, Draper)</a>	Small power metal lathes ungeared
P	<a href="#">Toastmaster tools</a>	Some normal, some oddball tools
P	<a href="#">Unimat</a>	Lathes and small lathe tooling
P	<a href="#">Wappat/Alta Depression era</a>	Depression era *(with Alta tools)
